## The CARES ACT Waives Prescription Requirement for Over-the-counter Medicines

The <u>Coronavirus Aid</u>, <u>Relief</u>, and <u>Economic Security Act (CARES Act)</u> was signed into effect, giving Health Savings Accounts (HSA), participants access to additional eligible products including:

- Over-the-counter (OTC) drugs and medicines like fever reducers and cold remedies no longer require a prescription to be reimbursed through a pre-tax account, so stock up and stay healthy.
- Menstrual care products like pads, tampons, liners, cup sponge, or similar products are now eligible. This is good news for women everywhere.

The bill is retroactively effective as of January 1, 2020.
